8.4. Rainbow Drive Crossing Guard

The Rainbow Drive/Alderbrook intersection has many cars and is very dangerous, especially in the morning when everyone is trying to get to school on time (cars driving fast, kids running across the street, bikers not stopping). There have been a few incidents of near accidents and it is a big safety issue. Can we get a crossing guard there? Lisa has called the city and left some messages.
