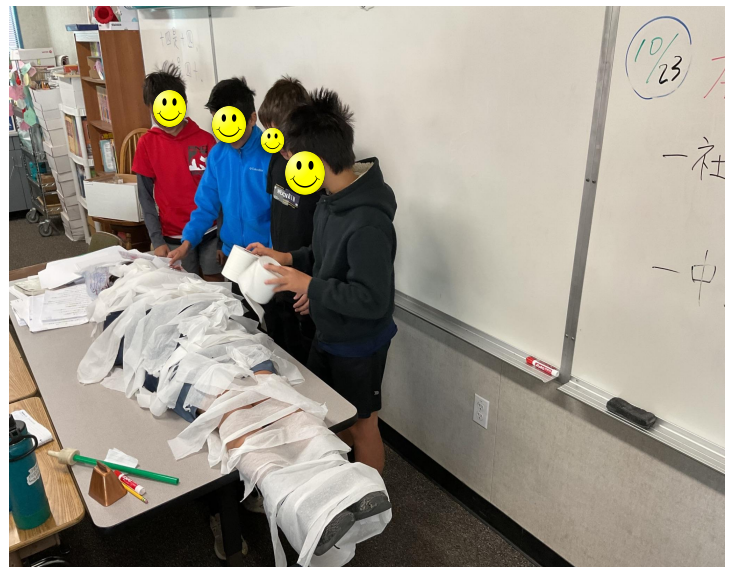
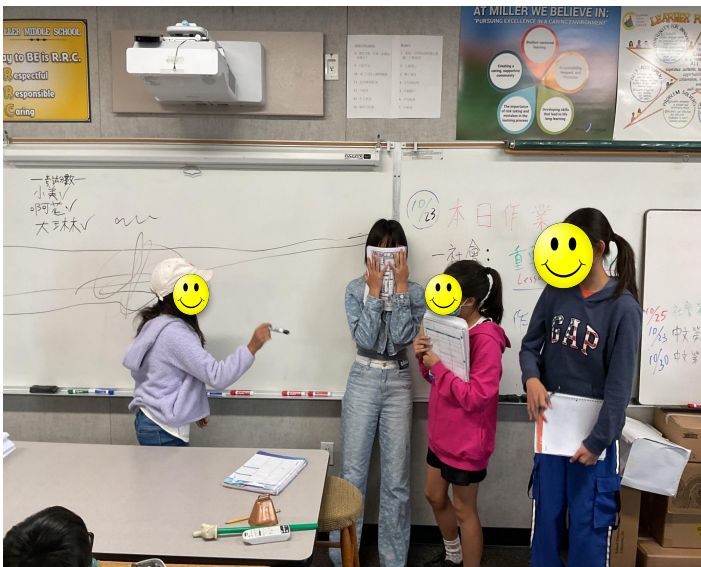
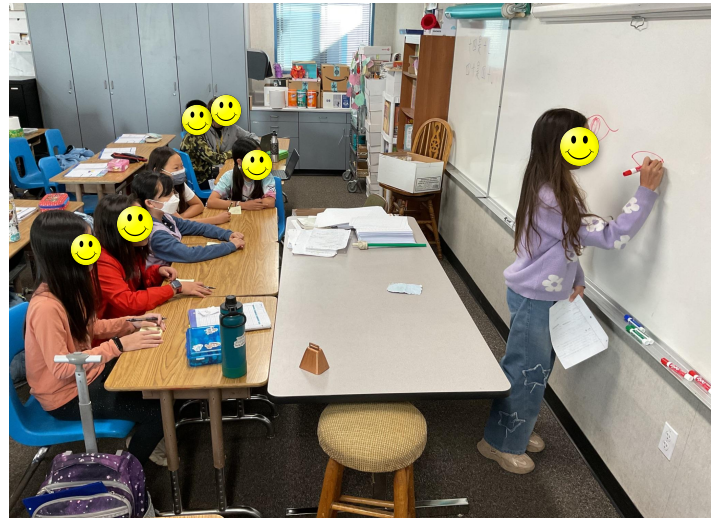
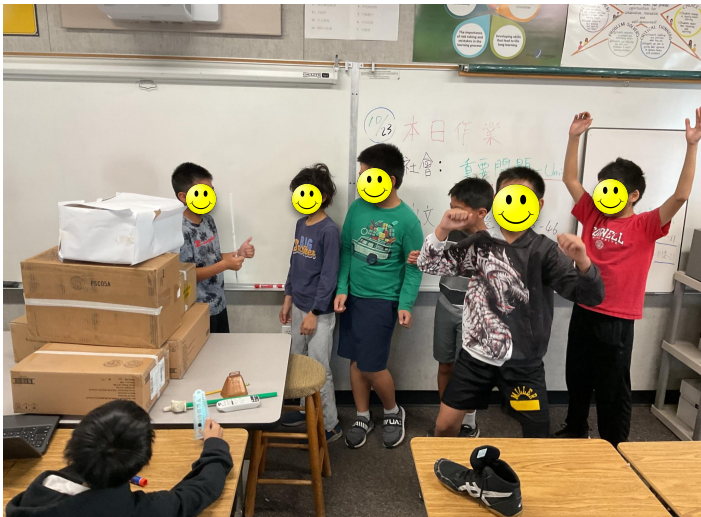
# Miller News 米樂校園

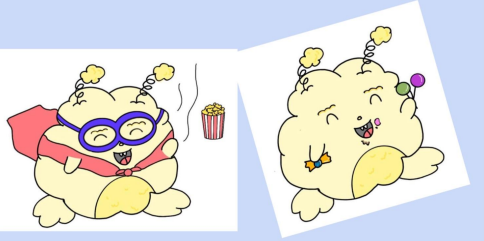

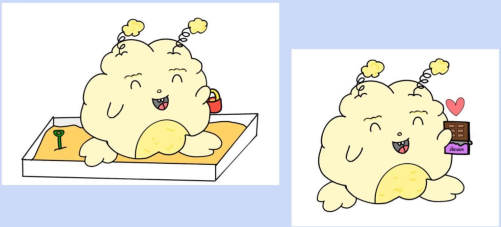

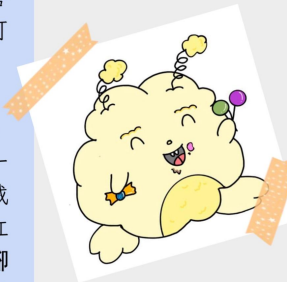
### 小怪物

## Registration and Lottery for CLIP for New Students

If you have a child not yet in CLIP, you will need to register the child with CUSD, then participate in the open enrollment lottery. If your child is at another CUSD elementary or middle school, you do not need to register again but will need to do lottery. Information can be found at <https://www.cusdk8.org/departments/student-assignment> under “Requirements”, “Student Registration” and “Open Enrollment”. Parent information meetings about Priority Registration and Open Enrollment will be held via Zoom on Tuesday, November 12th at 6:00 pm and Wednesday, November 20th at 6:00 pm. To receive updates and notifications via email regarding Priority Registration or Open Enrollment, please [CLICK HERE](#) to join CUSD’s ParentSquare Community Group.

The Priority Registration Window will be from December 2, 2024 through January 22, 2025. The Priority Open Enrollment Window for CLIP will be from January 10, 2025 through January 24, 2025.

**\*Participation in the alternative school/program lottery\*\* requires attending a mandatory tour/meeting**—visit the alternative school’s website to sign up for a tour/meeting.

**\*\*The living waitlist will end this year** and the 2025-2026 Open Enrollment lottery will create a new waitlist for every grade level at each alternative school/program.

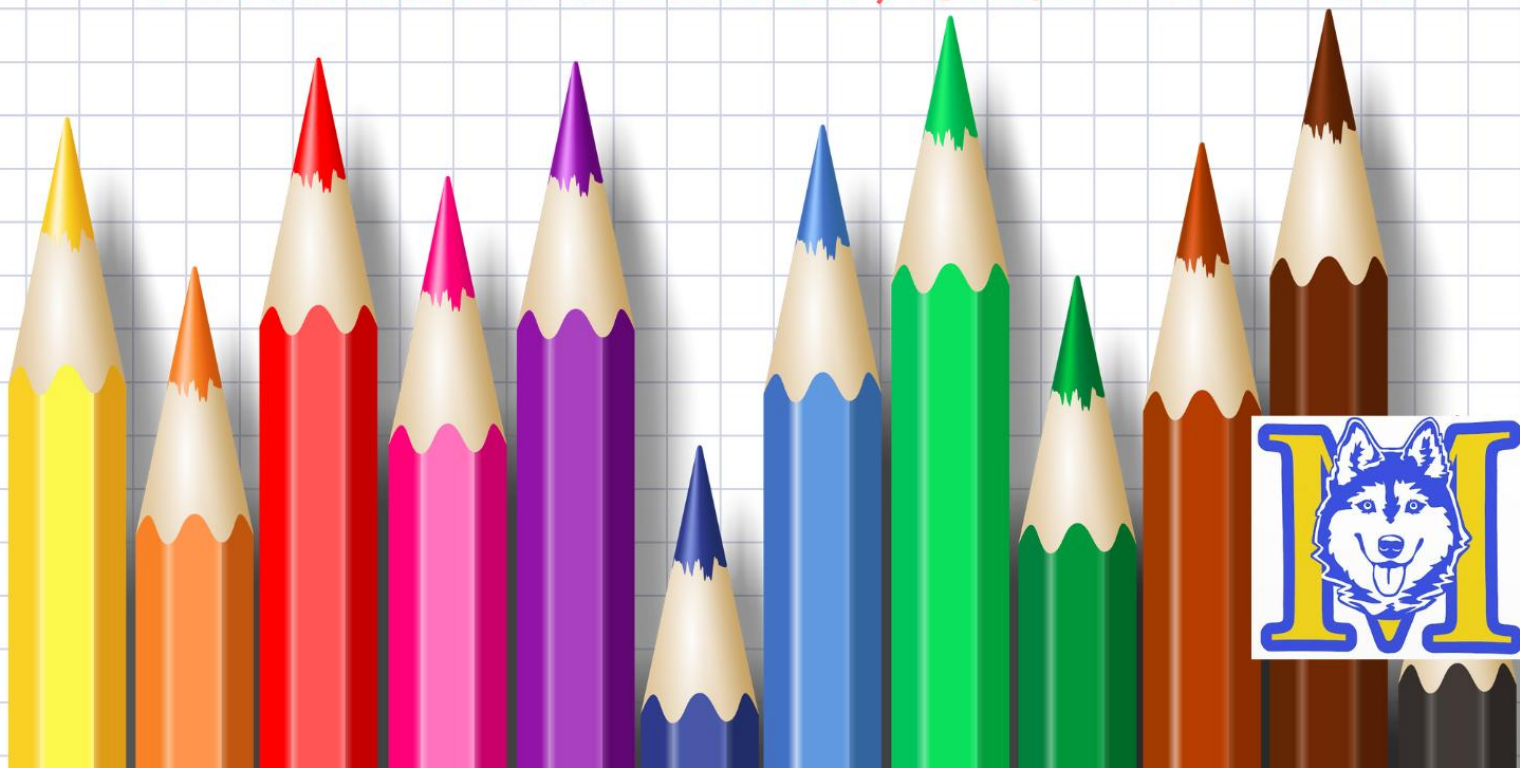

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



### WHAT PROJECTS WOULD BE PART OF MEASURE Z?

- Repairing or replacing leaky roofs and plumbing systems
- Expanding Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics classrooms and labs
- Repairing or replacing inefficient heating, ventilation and air-conditioning systems
- Creating greater accessibility to classrooms, restrooms, walkways and playgrounds in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)
- Renovating school libraries and media centers
- Upgrading fire alarm and emergency communication systems
- Improving counseling, mental health and special education facilities

### WHAT IS MEASURE Z?

Measure Z is a general obligation (GO) bond measure on the November 5, 2024, Presidential Election ballot. If approved by 55% of ballots cast, it is expected to extend but not increase the district's current tax rate to authorize \$347 million to make critical renovations and improve schools and classrooms throughout the Cupertino Union School District. In addition, voter approval of Measure Z will allow the district to qualify for state matching funds.

### WHAT IS A GO BOND?

California school districts commonly use GO bonds to fund improvement projects, such as constructing and renovating classrooms. Similar to a home loan, GO bonds are repaid over time. Funds to repay the bonds come from a tax on all taxable property—residential, commercial, industrial and agricultural—located within the district.

### HOW MUCH WILL MEASURE Z COST?

Measure Z is estimated to have an average annual tax rate of less than \$21 per \$100,000 of assessed valuation. Assessed valuation should not be confused with market value. The assessed valuation is the value placed on property by Santa Clara County and is typically lower than market value.

### WHAT TAXPAYER PROTECTIONS ARE IN PLACE?

Measure Z ensures full public disclosure of all spending. An independent Citizens' Oversight Committee must review and report on all bond expenditures, and a third-party auditor must audit all bond expenditures. Measure Z includes a specific list of projects on which bond funds may be spent. Laws prohibit funds from being used for administrators' salaries, pensions or benefits. Measure Z bond funds must be spent on Cupertino Union School District's projects and cannot be taken by the state.

### HOW DO I VOTE BY MAIL?

All registered voters in California will receive a vote-by-mail ballot. If you need to register to vote, you can register online at [www.registertovote.ca.gov](http://www.registertovote.ca.gov). Once you complete your ballot, sign your ballot envelope and simply drop your ballot in the mail—postage is prepaid—by November 5, 2024. ### 常見問題

#### 哪些專案將成為措施Z的一部分？

- 維修或更換漏水的屋頂和管道系統
- 擴大科學、技術、工程、藝術和數學教室和實驗室
- 維修或更換低效的供暖、通風和空調系統
- 根據《美國殘疾人法案》(ADA)，增加教室、洗手間、人行道和遊樂場的可及性
- 翻新學校圖書館和媒體中心
- 升級火災報警器和緊急通訊系統
- 改善諮詢、心理健康和特殊教育設施



#### 措施Z是什麼？

措施Z是2024年11月5日的一般義務(GO)債券措施，總統選舉選票。如果55%的選票獲得批准，預計將延長，但不提高該區目前的稅率，授權3.47億美元進行批評 整個庫比蒂諾聯合學校的學校和教室的翻新和改善 地區。此外，選民對措施Z的批准將使該區有資格進入州 配套資金。

#### 什麼是GO債券？

加州學區通常使用GO債券來資助改善專案，例如 建造和翻新教室。與住房貸款類似，GO債券會隨著時間的推移而償還 償還債券的資金來自該區內所有應稅財產(住宅、商業、工業和農業)的稅收。

#### 測量Z將花費多少錢？

措施Z估計每10萬美元的評估估值平均年稅率低於21美元。評估估值不應與市場價值相混淆。評估估值是聖克拉拉縣對房產的價值，通常低於市場價值

#### 有哪些納稅人保護措施？

措施Z確保所有支出的全面公開披露。獨立的公民監督委員會必須審查和報告所有債券支出，第三方審計師必須審計所有債券支出。措施Z包括一份可以用於債券資金的具體專案清單。法律禁止將資金用於管理人員的工資、養老金或福利。措施Z債券資金必須用於庫比蒂諾聯合學區的專案，不能由州政府拿走。

#### 我如何透過郵件投票？

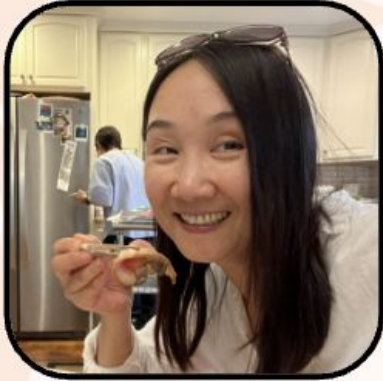
