

8th Grade Only: Lynbrook Transfer Process

This information is for Miller 8th Grade families who do not live in the Lynbrook boundary area and would like to enroll their 8th grader in Lynbrook High School next year.

This year, Lynbrook is continuing the opportunity for any 8th grader at Miller, if they live in the Fremont Union High School District boundaries (regardless of feeder high school), to enroll at Lynbrook through the LSSAP program.

Here is the <u>Lynbrook website</u> to explain the program's criteria and the process for applying for transfer. There is a link to this site on the Lynbrook homepage.

It is very important that, though eligible Miller students (who do not have Lynbrook as their feeder high school) will be accepted for transfer, they MUST submit their applications by the deadline. As always, students who live in the Lynbrook attendance area do not need to complete a transfer application.

Lynbrook will host a Shadow Day for a limited number of eligible transfer students on Friday, January 2. 2025. This event is geared towards students rather than parents. Lynbrook will have an information night for eligible families at Lynbrook on Thursday, January 9, 2025, in the theater at 7 PM.

HOW TO APPLY TO CLIP AT MUIR FOR THE 2025-26 SCHOOL YEAR

Step 1: Register your child at the Student Assignment Office

- For students new to CUSD, registration must be completed to receive a Perm ID#
- For CUSD students not in CLIP, your student has a Perm ID# and that can be retrieved through ParentVue or through the office at the school they currently attend.

Please visit: https://cusdk8org.finalsite.com/departments/student-assignment#fs-panel-21976 for registration information or contact your attendance area/neighborhood school. Registration will be open through January 22, 2025.

Step 2: Attend a Parent Information Meeting

- You must register for a **Mandatory Parent Information Meeting:**
 - January 8 at 12:00 PM Link to Registration
 - January 15 at 11:00 AM <u>Link to Registration</u>
 - January 24 at 9:00 AM <u>Link to Registration</u>
 - You must have a Perm ID# for your student to register
 - If you have a sibling currently attending Muir, this meeting is not required (but you
 MUST register to receive a perm ID# to apply during Open Enrollment)

Attending one of these parent information sessions does not enter your child in the lottery.

Step 3: Apply via the Open Enrollment link

• The link will be on the CUSD website and will be live at 8:00 am January 10, 2025, and will close at 4:00 pm on January 24, 2025 - absolutely no exceptions will be made for these deadlines.

The Priority Open Enrollment Lottery will be done electronically on <u>or before January 31st.</u>
Lottery results will be live on <u>February 21st.</u>

Waitlist numbers will be reset at the beginning of each year. If you wish to continue to be considered for enrollment in the CLIP program, you **MUST** join a meeting and apply for Open Enrollment **each year**.


