We like to celebrate the teachers by bringing in a little something to them every day, so here are some suggested items:

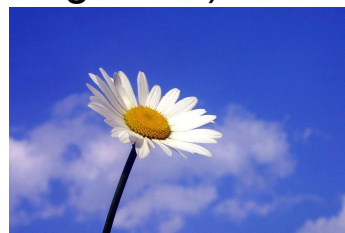
5/5 Monday: Staff Learning Day (No school)
