Crosswalk Safety Flags

Information for John Muir Families

For families who drive or cross the street at the Hanover and Alderbrook intersections, you may have noticed the safety flags on the sign posts. Girl Scout Troop 62748 identified a need to improve safety and, in partnership with John Muir Elementary School and CLIPCO, installed the crosswalk flag holders and flags over the summer.

We welcome families to use these flags as they cross these intersections, even if there are fewer cars during non-commute hours. These flags improve visibility and increase safety for pedestrians crossing the road, especially smaller kids. Parents are encouraged to pay attention while driving and to use the flags when crossing the street which will teach and model behavior to children.

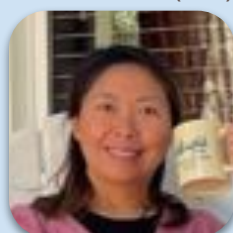

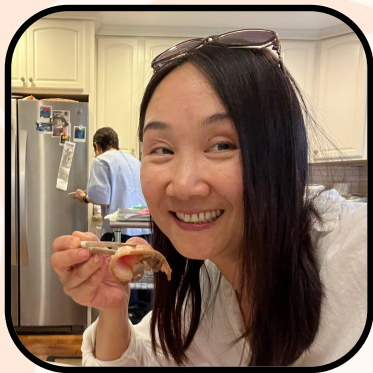

Not pictured: the teachers were treated to a dinner by CLIPCO that evening so that they could stay at school and prepare to meet the parents of the students in their class.

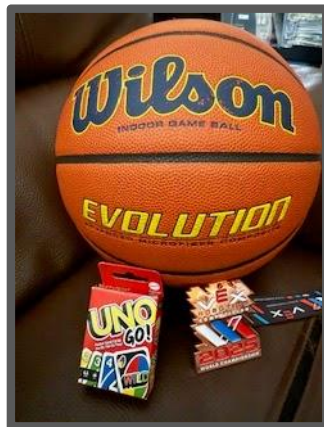



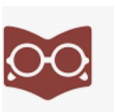
