AAPPL Assessment

Dear Parents/Guardians,

From 1/12 - 1/16, all Cupertino Language Immersion Program (CLIP) students at Miller will take the AAPPL Chinese (Mandarin) test, a language proficiency assessment. The AAPPL assessment is an opportunity to demonstrate progress on bilingualism and biliteracy competence and demonstrate their language knowledge and skills in Chinese.

AAPPL is a computer-based assessment which contains four sections:

1. interpersonal listening and speaking,
2. presentational writing
3. interpretive listening
4. Interpretive reading skills.

AAPPL test takers receive a separate score for each of the components or mode assessed. AAPPL Measure scores range from Low range of Novice Low (N-1) to Advance Low (A). Please see the [Resources for Parents](#) flier for more information.

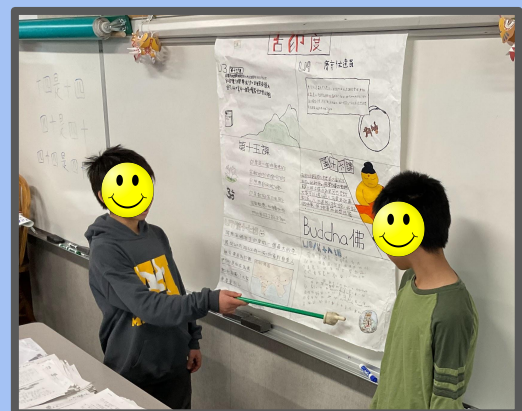
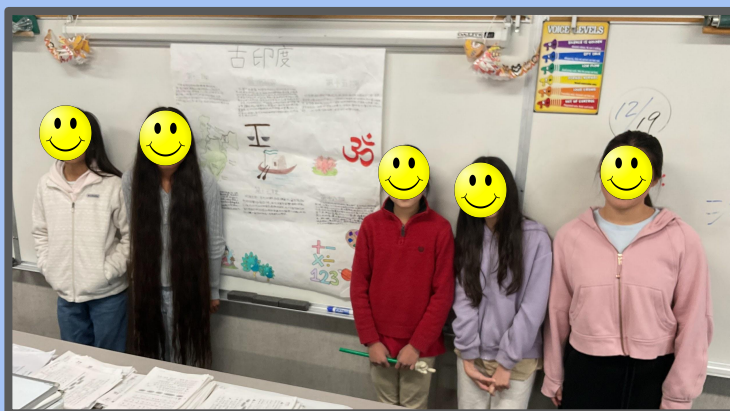
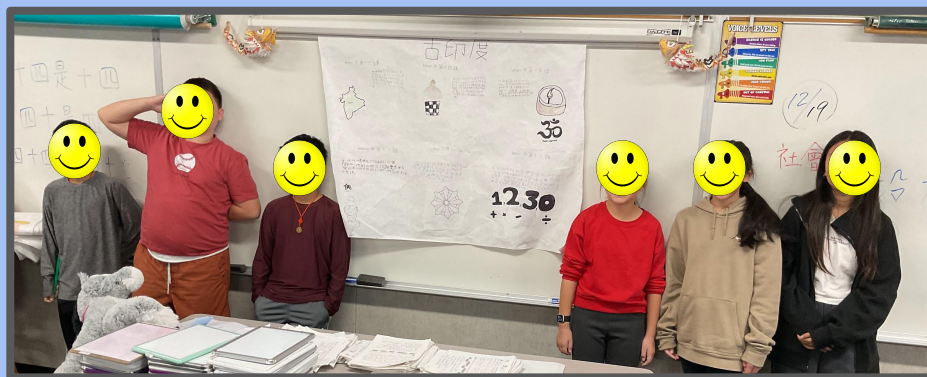
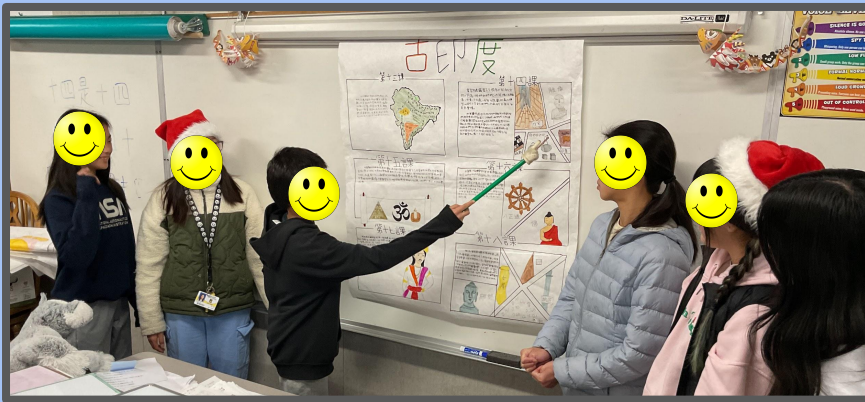
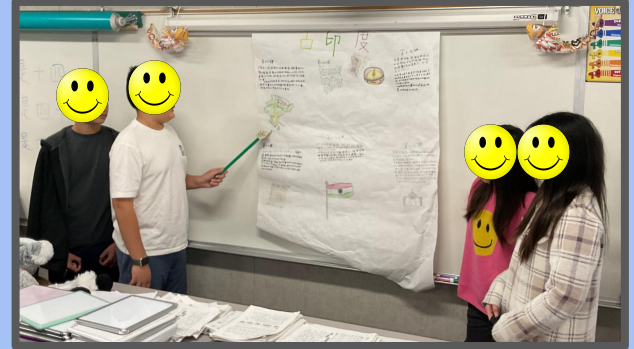
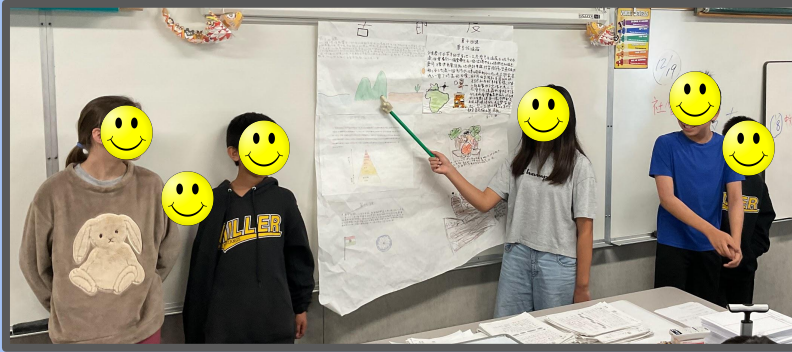
Students who receive N2/above on all 4 sub domains and show proficiency in the English Language through NWEA assessment are considered for the biliteracy certificate at the end of the year.

內容簡介: 現代生活中, 什麼都要人們訂閱成為會員: 刮鬍刀、牙膏、咖啡、影音平台, 連冰箱都想叫人們加入會員。東西不好用、對環境不好, 取消會員卻超麻煩, 花半小時還要驗證碼。平台推薦也很離譜, 看《怪奇物語》卻推《小豬佩奇》。最後我發現, 如果世界末日來了, 我至少還有用不完的牙膏。美國夢死了, 訂閱夢來了。

Act Overview: This xiangsheng pokes fun at modern life, where almost everything requires a subscription—razors, toothpaste, coffee, streaming services, and even smart refrigerators that try to sign people up as members. Many of these products don't work well and are bad for the environment, yet canceling a subscription is frustrating and time-consuming, often taking half an hour and endless verification steps. Streaming platforms also give bizarre recommendations, like suggesting *Peppa Pig* right after *Stranger Things*. In the end, the speaker jokes that if the world ever ends, at least they'll have an unlimited supply of toothpaste. The American Dream may be gone, but the "Subscription Dream" is here.



內容簡介: 以「父母是偽君子」為主題, 兩個學生吐槽父母的雙標行為: 不讓孩子刷手機、邊做事邊吃零食、打破杯子, 卻自己天天刷手機、吃零食、犯錯也沒事。透過角色對話, 表現出家庭中常見又真實的矛盾, 幽默又有共鳴。

Act Overview: This xiangsheng is about "Parents Are Hypocrites." Two students humorously call out their parents' double standards—getting scolded for using phones, eating snacks while doing things, or breaking a cup, while their parents do the same without any consequences. Through funny dialogue and role-play, the performance shows everyday family conflicts in a way that's both relatable and entertaining.

Act Overview: This xiangsheng is about a parent talking with her child about the impact of artificial intelligence on learning and daily life. The child relies on AI to handle exams, homework, and future work, while the parent worries that technology will encourage laziness and avoidance. Through humor, the performance highlights that while technology can support learning, it cannot replace effort and personal choices—true growth still depends on the individual.

八年級歷史課：脫口秀 - 訪問建國先賢

這個活動讓學生分成四到五人一組。一個人當主持人，其他人扮演不同的建國先賢，做一場「歷史訪談脫口秀」。每個人要先查資料，了解自己角色做過什麼、說過什麼名言，還參與過哪些重要事件。表演時，主持人會發問，每位來賓至少要回答三個問題，其中一定要有一題跟獨立、憲法或人民權利有關。透過這種輕鬆又好玩的方式，學生不但能更了解建國先賢，還能練習說中文、學新詞彙、一起合作，用互動的方式把歷史變得更有興趣。

8th-grade History Class: Talk Show —In this activity, students worked in groups of four to five. One student was the host, and the others played different Founding Fathers, turning it into a “history talk show.” Each student researched their character, including their contributions, famous quotes, and important events they were involved in. During the performance, the host asked questions, and each guest answered at least three questions, with at least one question related to independence, the Constitution, or individual rights. Through this fun and interactive format, students developed a better understanding of the Founding Fathers, practiced speaking Chinese and learning new vocabulary, worked as a team, and made history more engaging.


In order to be considered qualified to participate in the LHS Supplemental School Assignment Program, students must meet BOTH of the following criteria:

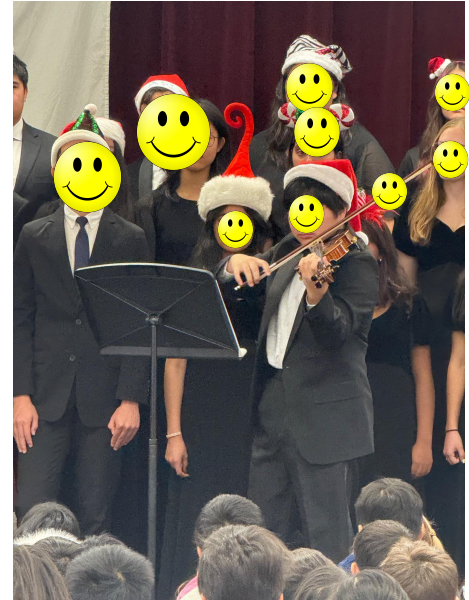

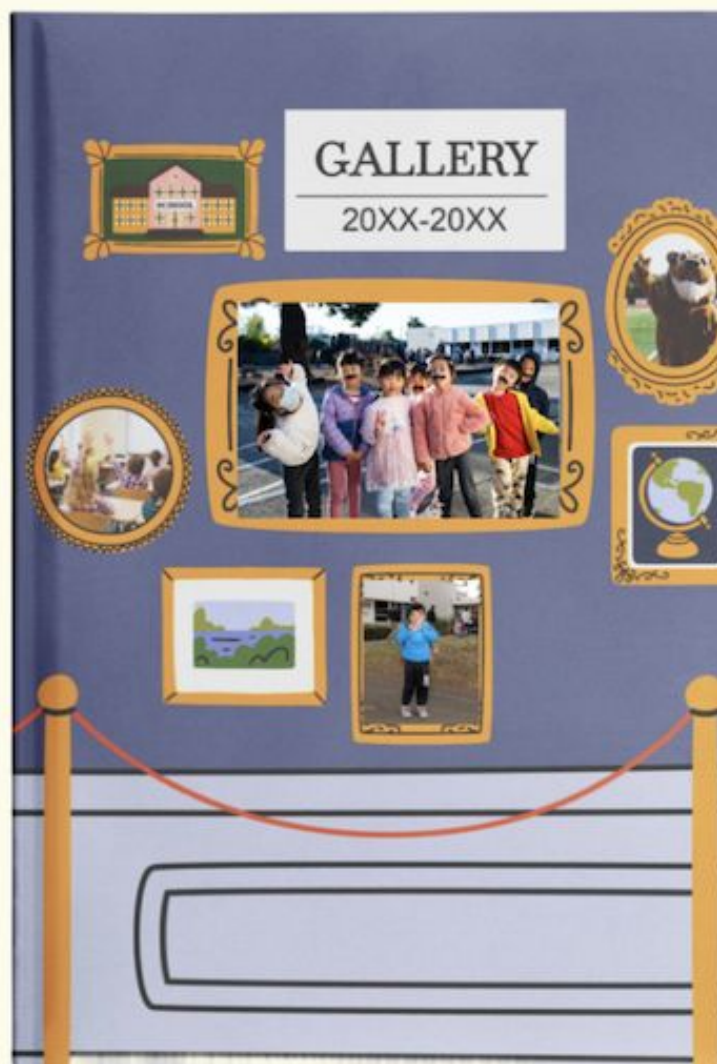

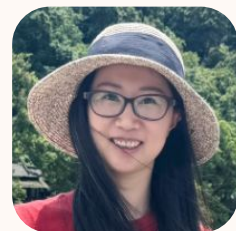
