Although writing in Mandarin did not directly help me understand the historical event, writing the commentary itself helped me gain a better understanding of my specific topic.

Writing a commentary on a historical fiction text helped me understand the topic more deeply. It gave me a clearer and more meaningful understanding.

孙心妍 Caroline Sun:

Through researching and writing, I was able to understand the topic in greater depth. I learned about the origins of the event, the important people involved, and the consequences that followed.

People have different perspectives on political topics. Throughout history, certain themes repeat across different eras, and the motivations of historical figures are often examined and discussed.

鍾雋仁 Jeremy Chung:

I understood my topic much better than before, beyond just a surface-level understanding. The process was very helpful. I learned about the contents of the 12th Amendment and how voting worked before it was passed.

张陶然 Toran Zhang:

I think writing the commentary in Chinese especially helped me understand the topic. While translating, I had to think carefully about what each sentence meant, which allowed me to gain a deeper understanding.

李宇祥 Carter Lee Lambert:

Presenting the commentary was not the most important part; the in-depth research mattered more. Learning and researching Chinese terms forced me to go deeper, uncovering interesting facts and persuasive ideas. Listening to others' presentations also helped me learn new information without having to research everything myself.

蒲汝欣 Alison Paul:

Writing the commentary in Chinese helped me better understand the concept I was translating. In order to translate accurately, I first needed to fully understand what I was learning.

顧正梅 Szilvia Gutmann:

Writing this commentary helped me understand different people's views on political dilemmas and conflicts. It also helped me think more carefully and form my own opinions about these issues.

黃希哲 Oliver Wong:

Writing this commentary on foreign alliances helped me understand that many Federalists who opposed the French Revolution were wealthy, aristocratic individuals. They were concerned that the violence in France might spread to the United States.

蔡尚凌 Sheung-Ling Choi:

One thing I learned while explaining the background is that the Federalists supported a strong centralized government based on merchants, factories, and trade. In contrast, the Democratic-Republicans emphasized individual rights and an agricultural, self-sufficient economy.

陳韞華 Jocelyn Chen:

Writing this commentary helped me understand why Washington was so concerned about the nation and why he strongly favored neutrality. It also helped me realize the importance of a peaceful transfer of power and preventing political violence.

徐佳馨 Sophie Tsui:

Writing this commentary helped me gain a deeper understanding of how art and literature in the past shaped the national identity we recognize today.

篠原美和 Miwa Shinohara:

Writing and preparing for the commentary helped me develop a deeper understanding of the topic and think more critically about historical events. Answering the questions required research that also helped me form my own opinions.
