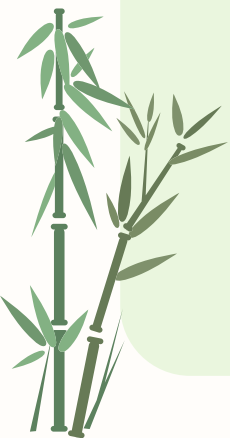
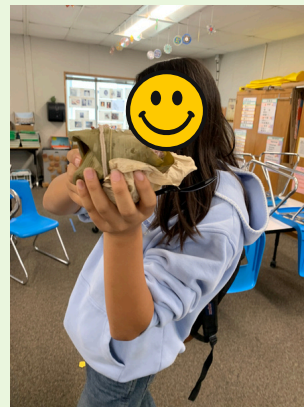
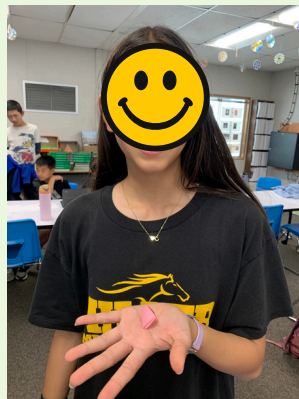
The 7th graders held their first debate in May. Each class had three groups debating health-related issues.
