

Muir 2022 - 2023 ASEP Class Description:

- **Chinese Dance** - Students will develop basic dancing skills and an appreciation of Chinese culture. The instructor teaches at the International Performing Arts Center at Cupertino.
- **Dizi - Chinese Bamboo Flute** - Learn basic playing techniques of the Chinese bamboo flute. The teacher is from the California Youth Chinese Symphony.
- **Er-hu - Chinese string instrument** - Learn basic playing techniques of the Chinese 2 string bowed instrument. The teacher is from the California Youth Chinese Symphony.
- **Zhongruan** - Chinese plucked stringed instrument. The zhongruan has a straight neck with 24 frets on the fingerboard and 4 strings. It is usually played with a plectrum (guitar pick). It can also be played with fingers (index finger and thumb with acrylic nails), which is similar to the way of playing the pipa (琵琶). The teacher is from the California Youth Chinese Symphony.
- **Lion Dance I and II** - Lion dancing has been a dynamic and festive part of Chinese culture for a thousand years and the Muir-CLIP Lion Dance Team strives to keep that tradition alive. Students will develop muscular strength, mental discipline and cultural awareness. This class will include Lion Dance cultures, Lion dance movements and music.
- **Percussion** - Students will learn basic Chinese drum rhythms and techniques.
- **Wushu** - Students begin training with basic Shaolin kung fu forms for strength, conditioning and coordination. <https://shaolinwariormartialarts.com/>
- **Cooking** - Students will gain appreciation of cuisines around the world, increase knowledge of seasonal produce preparation, learn up-to-date cooking techniques, work effectively and sensibly in a team environment, celebrate creativity in culinary arts.
- **Brush Painting** - Students will learn this traditional art form by using different types of brushes to depict animals, flowers, fruit, or scenes from nature in either monochrom or colored style
